Roop Chanderdatt, Co-Owner, General Manager and Field Manager of the LONDON MAJORS is very pleased to announce that Chuncey Ward has signed to play with the Majors for the 2010 season.

Chuncey is 24 years old, 6'4", 235 lbs, throws right and is a switch hitter. Ward is from Macon, Georgia and played his college ball at NCAA-DII Albany State University in the SIAC Conference. Ward's primary position is shortstop, however he is versatile and can play catcher, first base and outfield.

In the 2008 season (senior year), Chuncey batted .427 (41st in the nation) with 171 At Bats. He scored 64 runs (14th in the nation) and had 73 hits. He hit a nation leading 24 doubles (4th in the nation), 6 triples (14th in the nation), 5 homeruns and had 41 RBI. He had a slugging percentage of .725 (39th) and drew 32 walks giving him an On-Base-Percentage of .517 (30th). Along with a fielding percentage of .933, Chuncey also showed his skills as a base runner with 23 stolen bases in 25 attempts (42nd).
