- played 2002 season in rookie ball with Medicine hat blue jays of the pioneer league
- played 2003 season with short season A Auburn (NY) Doubledays of the New York Penn League, and Advanced Single A Dunedin (Fla) Blue Jays of the Florida State League, and Triple A Syracuse (NY) Sky Chiefs of the International League.
- played 2004 with single A Charleston (WV) Alleycats of the South Atlantic League.
- 2005 released from Toronto and signed with Florence Freedom of the Frontier League. Starting center fielder in the all star game, also made post season all star team .344 average, 24HR, Frontier League record- 30 game hit streak
- Signed as a free agent with the Kansas City Royals before the 2006 season, spent half the season with Kansas City's affiliate in High Desert, California in the California League.
- Finished the 2005 season with the Evansville Otters of the Frontier League
